





P E T I T I O N

This petition, made and filed by the undersigned, Russell W. Bradley, Prosecuting Attorney in and for said County of Menominee, for and on behalf of the Board of Supervisors of said County, respectfully shows unto the Court:

1. That there is situated wholly within the boundary of said Menominee County a group of lakes, streams and flowages commonly called the "Shakey Lakes", certain of which are otherwise known as Bass Lake, Baker Lake, Little Spring Lake, Big Spring Lake, Resort Lake, and Long Lake.

2. That said lakes and streams and flowages are navigable and the portions thereof to be affected by the determination of their natural levels hereinafter proposed are within the confines of the following sections of the United States public surveys, to-wit:

Sections 18 and 19 of Township 35 North, Range 28 West, and Sections 13 and 24, Township 35 North, Range 29 West.

3. That it is expedient to have determined and established the normal height and level of the waters of said "Shakey Lakes" chain for the purpose of promoting the public health, welfare and safety, and the conservation of the natural resources of this county, and to maintain navigation on the waters thereof.

4. That for a period in excess of twenty years a dam has been maintained on the Shakey River at the point of its

origin on the western end of Long Lake, which dam at the time  
was built raised the level of the waters of said Shakey Lakes  
chain to their present height, and that the waters thereby im-  
pounded formed themselves into several of the lakes above named,  
and that expensive development of the lands along said lakes  
has been developed with reference to this level and which value  
can be maintained only if the levels of said lakes are main-  
tained at or about their present levels; that the County of  
Menominee has established a County Park, the usefulness of which  
to the public is dependent upon the levels of said lakes being  
maintained as aforesaid; that your petitioners believe that a  
determination of the normal levels of this lake is therefore  
necessary.

WHEREFORE petitioners pray:

1. That a day certain may be set by order of this  
Court for hearing this petition, of which hearing due notice  
shall be given according to the statute in such case made and  
provided.
2. That this Court thereupon determine the normal  
height and level of the waters in said Shakey Lakes chain and  
establish the same by order of the Court.
